KEEP THIS SAFE!

Know what to do in the
event of a village
emergency or crisis.

Any Crisis Could Happen:

- Extremes of weather e.g. big freeze, deep snow, flood, hurricane, heatwave
- Wildfire, drought
- Major road incident
- Gas explosion
- Prolonged power cut, water shortage
- Cyberattack, no power or means of communication
- Pandemic or health emergency

What is an Emergency Plan?

In a crisis, a team of designated local coordinators will activate our Emergency Plan and liaise with emergency services, and communicate with the village.

This may be by village Facebook, local WhatsApp groups or a villager communication hub will be set up at the Recruiting Sergeant pub if other communication means are down.

Safe shelters will be opened up as appropriate by the coordinators (see page 3).

Having an agreed plan means:

- You know how to prepare for unforeseen events
- You know the safe places to go
- Key contact numbers are easy to find
- You can act calmly and quickly
- Help can reach those in need faster

How You Can Help

- Check on elderly, disabled, or isolated neighbours
- Offer temporary shelter, warmth, or reassurance
- Follow instructions from emergency coordinators
- Stay calm and avoid unnecessary travel
- BUT do not put yourself in danger to help.

Emergency Supplies

What supplies might you need to survive for days, during a crisis before help can arrive, or if you need to evacuate quickly?

- Battery or wind-up torch
- Portable power bank for charging your mobile phone
- Battery or wind-up radio for updates during a power cut (BBC Radio 2 & 4)
- Candles and matches
- First aid kit
- Wet wipes and hand sanitiser
- Bottled water supplies (if no mains water to drink, flush loo, wash etc)
- Non-perishable foods that do not require heating (e.g. tinned meat, fish, fruit, vegetables, puddings, long-life milk)

Know where to find

- Your insurance policies
- Your passport
- Any medication details

Keep these somewhere safe in case you need to get out of the house urgently.

Designated Safe Shelters

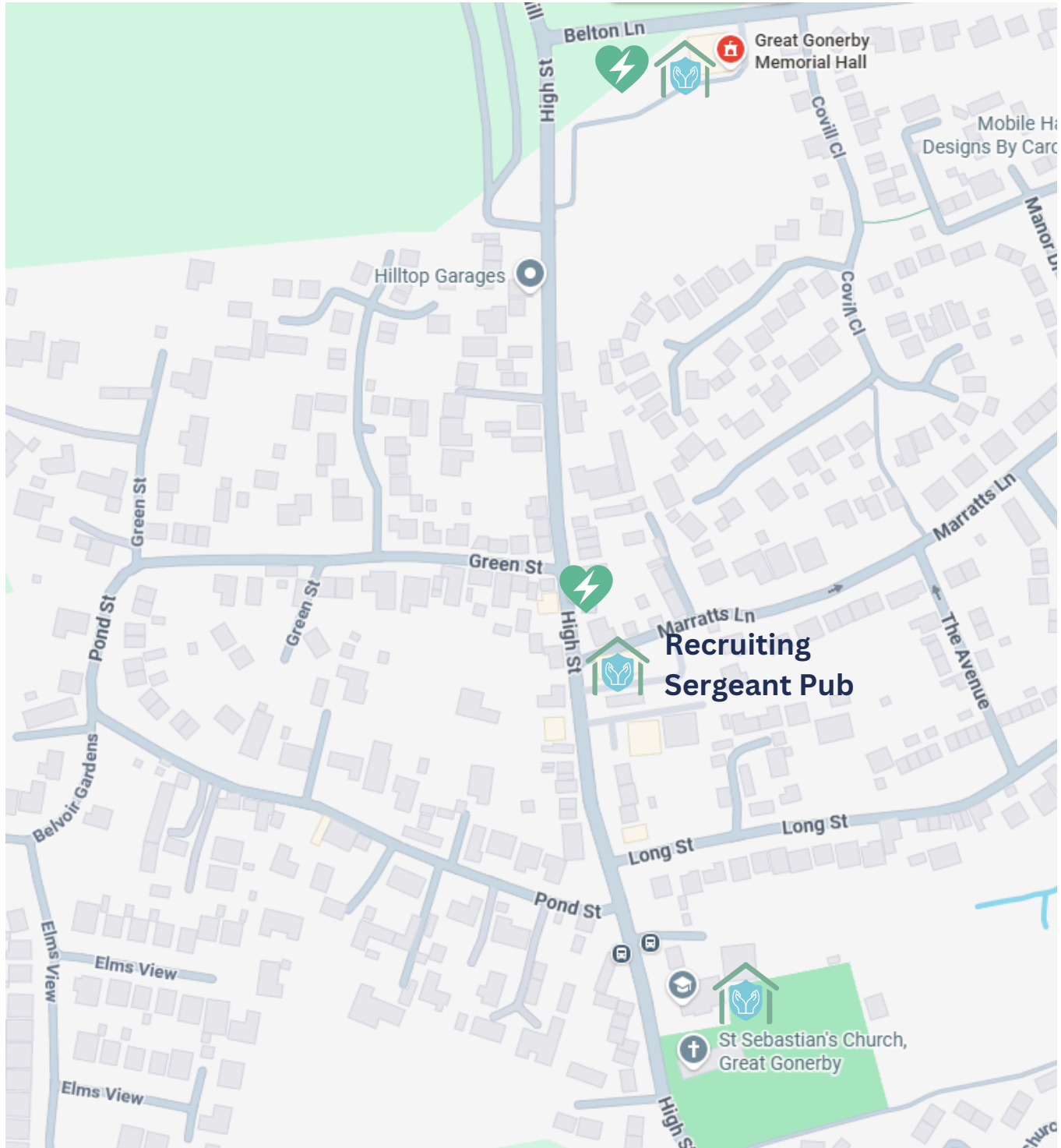
Volunteers needed!
